Antiheros fall typically into a few categories based on how they somehow became heroic in spite of lacking heroic features, or even having some less-than-heroic behaviors.

Lets start by contrasting:

Heroes typically believe in justice, fairness, idealism, propriety, doing the right thing, and deliberately saving the day. To a hero, being a hero is something worthy to aspire to, something they don't do for reward or fame, but as an altruistic action. Antiheroes may in fact be selfish, lacking in values, display morally ambiguous behavior, or even be an open coward.
